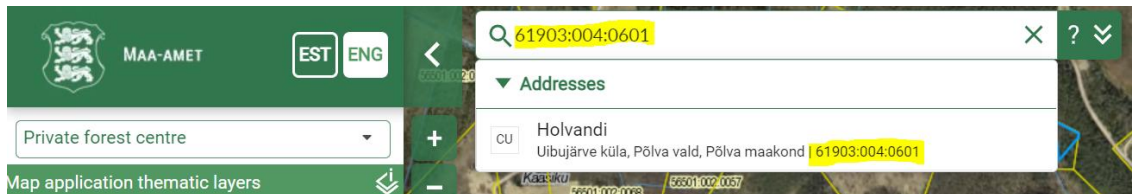


Printing instructions

1. Enter the cadastral ID in the search box and select the correct cadastral object by clicking with the cursor.



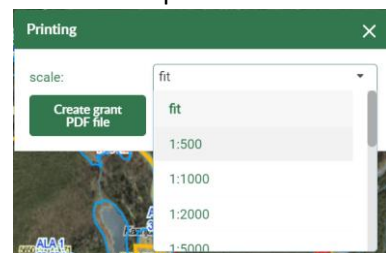
2. Click inside the cadastral unit highlighted with the cursor to make an information request.



3. The "Object info" tab opens and the sub-query "Cadastral unit with forest layer" opens on it, if there are forest support layers inside the given cadastral unit. Clicking on the text "**Find eligible areas**" on the tab will open a new "Analysis results" tab with all the individual forest plots in a separate line. Suitable forest areas can be turned on and off for printing.

4. Click the "**Print**" button on the "Analysis Results" tab, which opens new "Printing" tab. You can select the appropriate scale from the drop-down menu or have the forest areas automatically fit inside the printable screenshot.



5. Clicking the "**Create grant PDF file**" button will download it to your device.
6. When you open the downloaded file, you can print it using Ctrl+P or by searching for the printer icon at the top right and clicking on it with the cursor.
